LEGAL OPERATION OF UTV

Special Permit **REQUIRED**

- UTV's are allowed to travel on Logan Street within the city limits.
- UTV's **are not** allowed to be on 4th Ave (K-55) from the east city limits to the west city limits but may be crossed directly across to the other side of the street they are traveling.
- UTV's are allowed to be operated any time day or night.
- Only age 16 or older drivers with a valid driver's license may operate a UTV on a city highway, street, road, or alley within the corporate city limits of the city. (Driving permits do not qualify as a valid license). Operate means the licensed driver shall be in control of the steering and operation of the UTV at all times.
- Proof of insurance is required prior to the permit being issued and must be updated yearly or when it expires to maintain a valid permit for a UTV.
- No more persons shall be on a UTV than there are seats for. No passenger may be standing while the UTV is being operated.
- UTV's are expected to have headlights, tail lights, break lights and turn signals just as the Standard Traffic Ordinance (Article 18) for Kansas Cities states.
- Annual permit renewals are required January 1st of each year or prior to the first time operated each calendar year.
